The path to Refugee Settlement in Australia

Temporary Asylum

Families fleeing their homes seek temporary accommodation in a country of first asylum.





Referral for Resettlement in Australia

UNHCR

Refers refugees for resettlement in Australia. OR

Person is proposed under the Special Humanitarian Program by a family member in Australia.





Visa Applications Assessed

Application meets Visa criteria for the Refugee or Special Humanitarian Program.

The Department of Home Affairs Carries out security health, and character checks.



While still overseas the family may

take part in the Australian Cultural

Orientation program to help them

Visa Granted

prepare for life in Australia.

Selection of settlement location

The selection of a location for settlement in Australia will take into account family and community links, and services such as health, accommodation and language tuition.



Arrival in Australia

A Humanitarian Settlement Program (HSP) case manager meets families at the airport and takes them to their new home.
